1. *What are RAS reports?*

There are five public Range Authorization System (RAS) Reports: Allotment Information, Allotment Master, Authorized Use by Allotment, Operator Information, and Permits Schedule Information.

2. *Can I create a new report or edit an existing report from this website?*

No. The reports contained on this website can be viewed, but not edited or created.

3. *How often are the Reports updated?*

The Public RAS Reports are only updated when changes are made to the internal RAS transaction system.

4. *What does AUMs stand for?*

AUMs stands for Animal Unit Months, which is the unit used to charge a rancher for land use, depending on the type of animal.
